



Frequently Asked Questions

RELOCATION GRANT

Q

Initially, I was recruited internationally for a temporary appointment and was subsequently given a two-year fixed-term appointment. Now that my appointment is ending, I am relocating back to my home country. How is my relocation grant calculated upon separation?

A

Your relocation grant will be based on the allowance package coming with the two-year fixed term appointment. Accordingly, you can then receive a lump sum for unaccompanied shipment in the amount of \$15,000 USD at the family rate or \$10,000 USD at the single rate.

Q

How is the amount of the relocation grant calculated?

A

The amount of the relocation grant depends on the length of the appointments and movement and on the staff members family composition.

Q

I have to delay my repatriation travel for health reasons. Will I lose the entitlement to relocation grant?

A

If you have to delay your repatriation for compelling reasons, you can request for a deferral of your repatriation travel which will also defer your entitlement for relocation grant. Deferral is possible for up to two years and is subject to approval by the local HR official.
